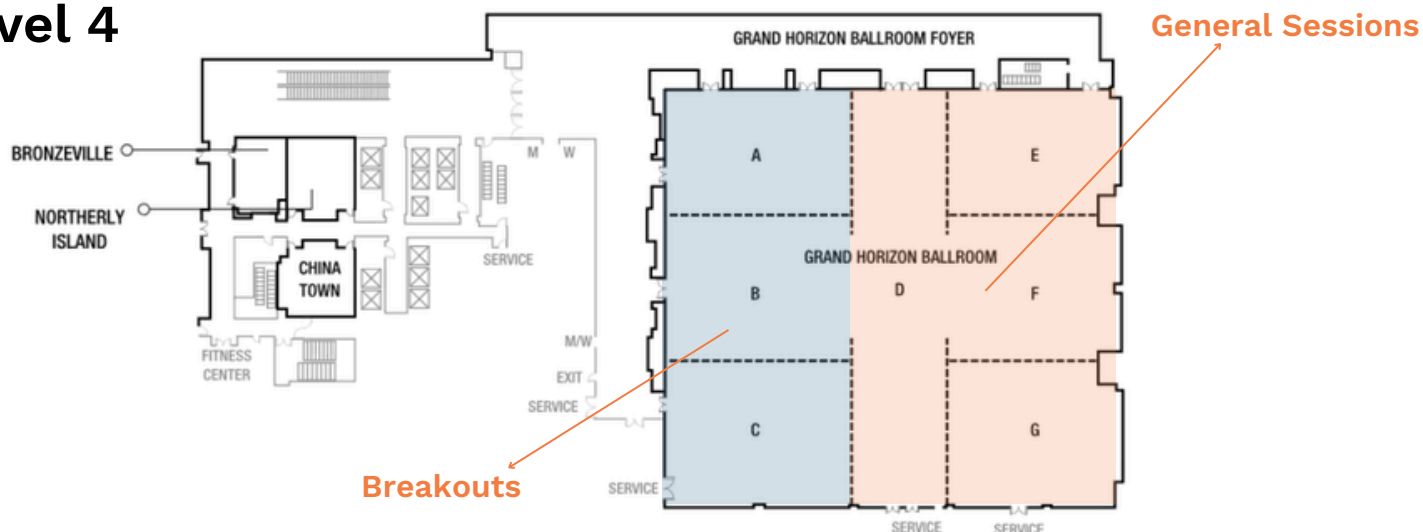

Meeting Space Layout

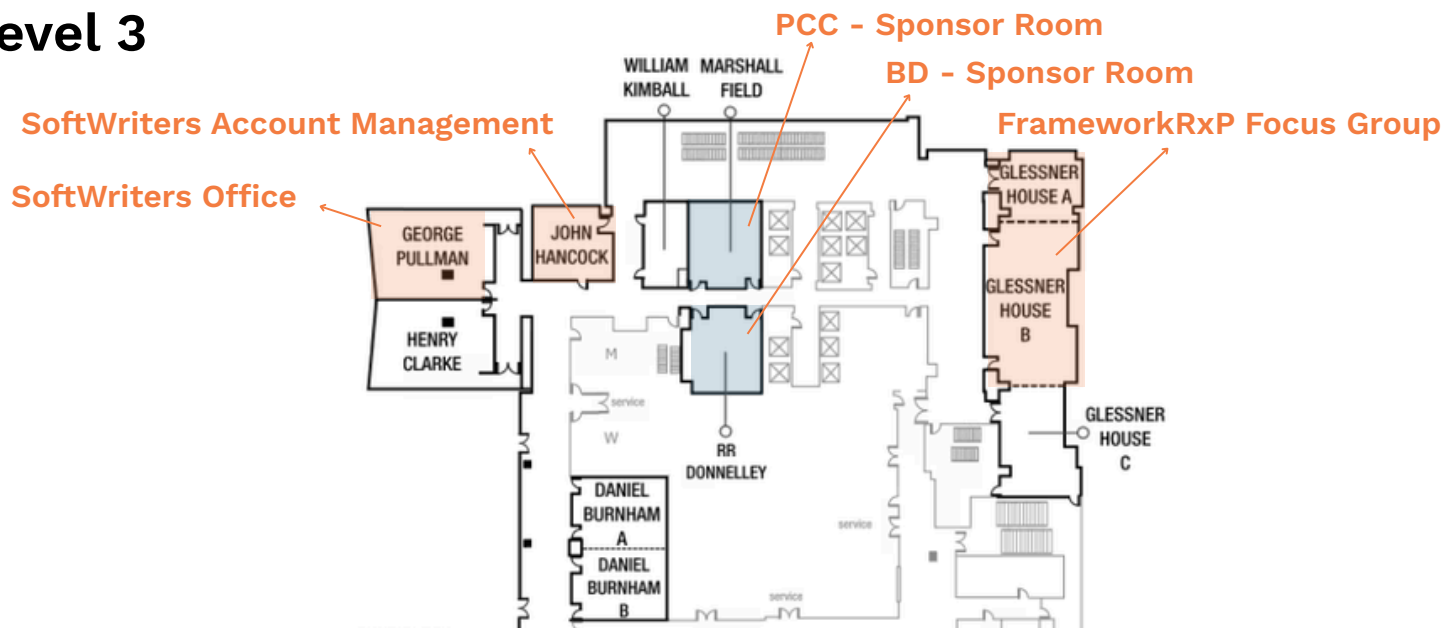
